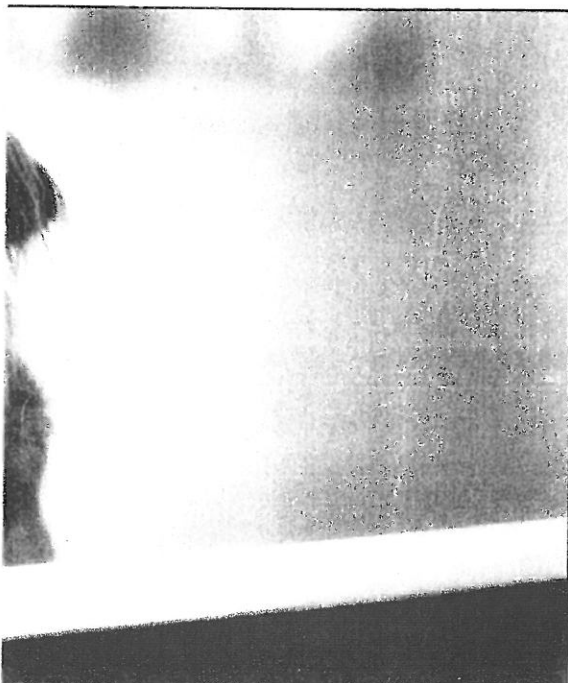


Eight easy tips on bathing your pet

1. Using lukewarm water rinse your pet well (hand-held showerheads are ideal for this).
2. Apply a sufficient amount of shampoo to the top of the neck and along the back of your pet.
3. **SPECIAL AREAS:** The face and ears should be washed with a soapy washcloth to avoid getting soap in the eyes or ears.
4. Work shampoo into a rich lather adding more lukewarm water, if necessary.
5. Rinse shampoo thoroughly from pet until water runs clear.
6. Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4.
7. Allow shampoo to sit 5-10 minutes.
8. Again, rinse shampoo thoroughly from pet until water runs clear of any shampoo.



A few good tips on cleaning your pet's ears

Always have your veterinarian examine your pet's ears before cleaning.

Clean the ear with a ceruminolytic (dewaxing agent). Fill the ear canal with the dewaxer and massage the solution into the ear. Wipe the ear with gauze or cotton swab. This will remove all of the wax build up in the ear.

NEVER USE A COTTON TIPPED APPLICATOR

Clean the ear with an ear cleanser. Following the same procedure as the ceruminolytic, fill the ear canal with the cleanser and massage the solution into the ear.

Wipe the ear with gauze or a cotton swab. Repeat the procedure until all dirt and debris is removed.
